We had this block all written out with the invite to worship at Upper Dublin on Sept. 9th for Unplug & Recharge ... but that was before Ida.



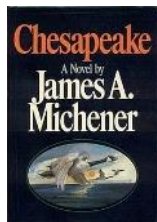
The grounds are not safe, with all of the hanging limbs and so many tree limbs and trunks strewn across all four sides of the meetinghouse.
